Clear Lake - Toxic Algae Results 10/1/2020

Dear Clear Lake Residents and Users,

Thurston County Health staff received results from an algae sample collected from Clear Lake on September 29, 2020. Results were **BELOW detection levels** for all toxins.

When there is an algae bloom present, we recommend extra precautions be taken to avoid the health risks posed by potential toxins.

- Stay out of the lake.
- Avoid contact with water containing algae.
- Keep pets and livestock away from areas where algae blooms are present
- Do not water ski, jet ski, paddle board, or boat in the lake during an algae bloom.
- When fishing, it is safest to catch-and-release any fish caught during an algae bloom.
- Do not drink water taken from the lake.
